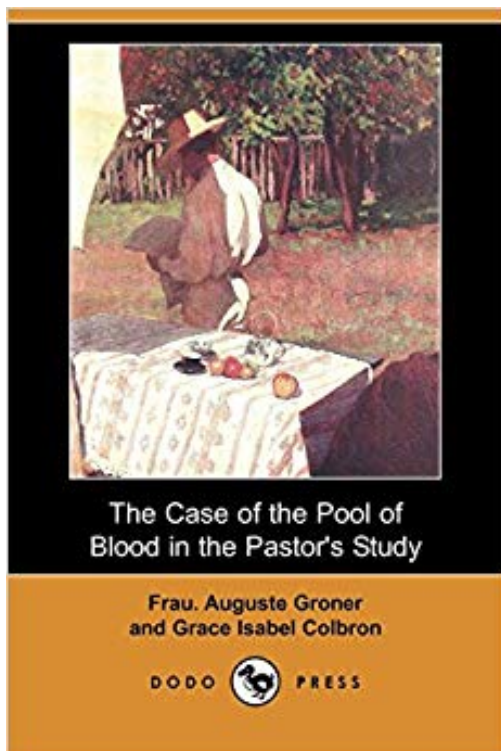

Frau. Auguste Groner (1850-1929) co-authored Grace Isabel Colborn (1869-1948) in writing a series of detective stories. The main character in the series was detective Joe Miller. They also collaborated in writing *The Lady in Blue* in 1922. Other works by Groner are: *The Man with the Black Cord* (1911) and *Mene Tekel* (1912). They were subsequently translated from German into English by Colborn. "Joseph Muller, Secret Service detective of the Imperial Austrian police, is one of the great experts in his profession. In personality he differs greatly from other famous detectives. He has neither the impressive authority of Sherlock Holmes, nor the keen brilliancy of Monsieur Lecoq. Muller is a small, slight, plainlooking man, of indefinite age, and of much humbleness of mien. "

As the title implies, a large amount of blood is found in a pastor's study, but there is no body there. This story takes place in Hungary, and fortunately Muller is there on business so he agrees to investigate. He is sure the missing pastor has been murdered due to the large amount of blood, but there are very few clues to go on. As is usual with Muller, he is able to find a trail to investigate from a very small clue. This is a good mystery, and I recommend it for those who enjoy late nineteenth century mysteries.
