

Don't let the age of this book (1978) deter you from joining those of us who have had the sheer splendid pleasure of partaking in its highly-detailed information concerning the correlation of sun signs and the pivotal role they play in the intimate relationships between people. At first sight, the book is very meaty (meaty to mean that it's a thick book), filled with pages of not only applicable love-bitten tidbits, but also, irrefutable advice (for the price) on levels of love that which current couples as well as those seeking cupid can actively attain and maintain simply through understanding and appreciating people for what the aspects surrounding their birth means.

With this book, you become equipped with love-knowledge, a knowledge that empowers you with an acute comprehension (as seen through Linda's vision) surrounding love-comparability based on various sun-signs. Linda went through a great deal of work and research to write about how each sign interacts with each other in relationships. She delves deeply into why some sun-signs work, why others struggle, but most importantly (a statement worth noting) is that while Linda's descriptions on blended-love based upon aspects of certain sun-signs seems quite accurate (from my own professional studies on human behavior) she makes it very clear to stipulate that ANY relationship can work if you TRY.

What to Expect: You can expect to see relationship comparisons for (just about) each sign. It has been my experience that people who are merely (into horoscope readings) tend to be only interested in their personal sun-sign or only that of the person with whom they are involved. When in actuality, embracing an conceptualization about all of the signs is your best tool as it will guide you not only through a path of self-realization, but help clarify possibly how other people connected to you professionally, personally and in love all function based on certain aspects determined by the stars at the time of their birth.

Open up your mind: LOVE is a short word with an in-depth meaning. LOVE can be applied to that with a partner or LOVE for your friends and family. For some, love comes naturally, some have to work hard at love, while others decide to simply act as if love is there when it's not. Whatever the case, this book will explain how sun-signs interact with each other and hopefully provide you with a start on love-connections or the ability to improve what you already have.

You should pay attention to any such emotional common sense and the reality of your situation at hand irregardless to what a daily horoscope says.
